

Eligibility for NO VAT

Chronically sick or disabled people with a long term physical or mental condition that has an adverse effect on their ability to carry out every day activities, may be able to purchase certain goods zero-rated for VAT. The National Advice Service on 0300 200 3700 can help you regarding your eligibility, if you are not sure. You must be certain of your eligibility before signing this form.

There are penalties for making a false declaration.

1. with a physical or mental impairment which has a longer term and substantial adverse effect upon their ability to carry out everyday activities OR
2. with a condition which the medical profession treats as a chronic sickness, such as diabetes. OR
3. who is terminally ill.

I acknowledge this does not include a frail person who is otherwise able bodied or any person who is temporarily disabled or incapacitated.
